

1. Introduction

This report forms part of the statutory procedure for the making of Variation 6 to the Kilkenny City and Environs Development Plan (KCEDP).

This report addresses the submissions received during the 4 week public consultation period, from the 10^{th} August to the 7^{th} of September 2018, in relation to the Proposed Variation.

The purpose of this report is to:

- summarise the written submissions/observations received in relation to the proposed variation during the public consultation period.
- set out the Chief Executive's response to the issues raised in the submissions/observations and;
- make recommendations to the Elected Members on the issues arising from the consultation process.

This report is being furnished to the Elected Members of Kilkenny County Council in accordance with Section 13(4) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, for their consideration.

1.1 Proposed Variation

The purpose of Variation No. 6 to the Kilkenny City and Environs Development Plan is "To change the zoning on a site (of 0.39 hectares) adjacent to the Parc na Gowan housing estate in Smithland South, Kilkenny City from Community Facilities to Phase 1 Residential in order to deliver social housing units in Kilkenny City on under-utilised, serviced lands within existing communities, in line with the Government's policy outlined in *Rebuilding Ireland*".
