Site Location & Description

Archersfield is a residential development consisting of 24 dwellings located within Kilmaganny Village. The dwellings are a mixture of detached and semi-detached 2 storey units. 4 no. dwellings are street-access buildings – i.e. access is directly onto the main road (R701). The remaining 20 units are accessed via an estate road with a single access onto the main road.

Planning History

P04/1196:

Permission granted subject to 34 no. conditions to Springwell Developments Ltd. for the erection of 20 no. fully serviced dwelling houses and associated site works, on 15th June 2005.

P06/1555:

Permission granted subject to 18 no. conditions to Springwell Developments Ltd. for 4 additional semi-detached dwelling houses on 25th January 2007.

TIC Request:

The formal application to have this development taken in charge was made by the developer on 21st January 2011. The application was referred to the various internal service areas of the council and based on the responses a schedule of necessary works was prepared. The developer engaged with the council and prepared CCTV surveys and as built drawings but progress slowed and the developer entered receivership in 2016.

Kilkenny County Council subsequently undertook remedial works to bring the development up to the necessary standard for taking in charge. Works were completed in 2017 and monies spent were subsequently claimed from the development bond.

Recommendation:

Having regard to the completion of the development in substantial accordance with the conditions attached to the grant of permission and the completion of all works as identified by the various internal service areas, I recommend that Kilkenny County Council initiate proceedings for the formal taking in charge of Archersfield, Kilmaganny, Co. Kilkenny, as outlined on the attached map.
